speech therapy, physical therapy, occupational therapy and day programming supports. Individual gets to keep their SSA funds, and it doesn't get applied towards care. The funding in this program is to purchase desired services as an "al a cart" method, but, it's not funding that comes to the individual. The funding gets funneled to the service provider, or Personal Support Worker of family choice. Funding is applied for via the PUNs waitlist.

<u>CHBSS</u> (Child Home Based Support Services), similar to adult home based services, the program would provide services in the family home, with a monthly allotment from the state to cover desired services. Services offered present as an "al a cart" menu where family/individual can select just those that they are interested in purchasing. Individual gets to keep their SSA funds, and it doesn't get applied towards care. Where CHBSS differs from adult, is that since the individual is in school during the day, the monthly allotment for desired services is lower. In addition, families must be willing to sign up for the All Kids state insurance program. Funding is applied for via the PUNs waitlist.

Group Home Placement for Children:

<u>Children's Group Home's</u> are homes located in the community that serve between four to eight individuals in them. They provide 24hr direct staff support, with access to nursing assistance. Individuals that reside in these settings attend local school districts for education. Funding is applied for via the PUNs waitlist.

<u>Children's Residential Schools</u> are campus like settings that provide on site schools or the option of attending the local school system as well as small group homes that have 24hr staff and nursing support. These programs are generally designed for children that require an intense level of behavioral support or have high medical needs. Funding is applied for via the PUNs waitlist.

Group Home Placement for Adults:

ICF/DD (Intermediate Care Facility for Developmentally Disabled) are settings where staff provide 24-hour supports to individuals to learn daily living skills. These group homes, located in the community, typically have 16 individuals residing in them, however there are larger homes in the state that average 100 to 300 beds. The larger ICF/DD's are generally reserved for individuals that are medically fragile, because they are the only developmental disability group homes that provide 24 hour nursing assistance in addition to direct staff support. The smaller, 16 bed settings offer the direct staff support and access to nursing staff, but the nursing staff are not immediately on site. Funding for ICF/DD settings are different in that an individual does not need to be on the PUNs waitlist to access them. The individual can seek a provider who is willing to offer services and once a PAS eligibility screen is done, can enter into placement. These placements therefore tend to be more immediate. Examples of this type(s) of service in local area is Apostolic Timber Ridge (75 beds)

<u>CILA</u> (Community Integrated Living Arrangement) are settings in the community with staff providing assistance 24 hours a day/7 days a week to care for individual's needs and to provide daily living skills. These homes have typically four to eight individuals residing in them.

There are also **Family and Intermittent CILA** programs. These would be if the individual seeking services would stay in a family home or their own apartment. Then staff would provide for about 15 hours a week of support. Additional hours may be requested if there is a need. Funding for these settings are accessed via the PUNS waitlist.

<u>Host Family</u> settings allow individuals to live in a family home with a foster family. Host Family provides between 20hour to 24hour support to the individual per day, depending on if the individual attends a vocational program. Daily Living Skills, medical, money issues, etc. would be addressed by the Host family. The foster family would undergo background checks and specific training to maintain their licensure to provide the service. Funding for this setting is accessed via the PUNs waitlist.
